		Campus Accommodation for Teachers:
		The university can provide different types of accommodations to its teachers with different types of payment:
		Furnished Accommodation: A teacher can be provided with a furnished accommodation in the ground floor of the guest house. University will provide a room with attached bathroom and facilities such as Air-conditioner, Refrigerator, two single-beds, geyser, sofa, study table, TV and chairs. University will consider this as transit residential allotment and all teachers on regular appointment will be allotted this accommodation. A teacher who is allotted this accommodation can continue here till a regular residential quarter is allotted with a Charge of Rs. 3500/- per month
		Accommodation in Hostel: These are purely temporary accommodation and the teacher is expected to vacate such accommodation at the first opportunity.
		Few furnished rooms will be available under this category. These rooms are for teachers who are appointed on temporary basis. The idea is that a teacher, who is appointed for less than one year, is not expected to acquire household goods. University will provide a minimally furnished room so that the teacher can live in the campus. These rooms will have attached bath. Such accommodation will be charged unless the teacher is appointed as warden of the hostel.

	 The room will be charged as follows: - Type III – Rs. 1000/- per month (Non-AC) Type II – Rs. 1200/- per month (Non-AC) Type I – Rs. 1500/- per month (Non-AC) and an additional amount of Rs.1500/- per month to be charged if this room is equipped with AC. Wardens will be provided such accommodation free of rent. Matter is placed before Executive Council for consideration. Resolution: The Executive Council approved the campus accommodation charges for teachers.

	Prof. Ram Lakhan Meena joined the Central University of Rajasthan on 14 August 2013 as Professor under the School of Humanities & Languages with a probation period of one year.

Prof. Meena applied through proper channel and joined the University after getting relieved from his parent organization Satyawati College, University of Delhi, Delhi. He was sanctioned Extraordinary Leave (EOL) with lien for a period of two years *w.e.f.* date of joining, *i.e.* 14.08.2013. Prof. Meena was covered under old pension scheme at Satyawati College, Delhi.

Prof. Meena requested vide letter No. RLM/HoD/Hindi/Lien/2015-16/07 dated 10.06.2015 to continue in lien as per the decision/implementation of the "Mobility of faculty and non-faculty personnel to the newly established Central Educational Institutions (CEIs).

The UGC vide its letter F.No.51-1/2009(CU) dated 13 January 2012 clarified that the employees coming from pensionable establishments would be governed by pension scheme of parent department till such time they retain the lien with the parent post. In other words employees of new organizations (established on or after 01.01.2004) will be governed by New Pension Scheme (NPS).

After successful completion of the stipulated probation period of one year, the matter of confirmation of Prof. Meena was placed [Item 19-4.1] before the Executive Council in its 19th Meeting held on 27 May 2015 wherein the EC resolved to confirm the teachers on their respective posts including Prof. Meena from the date of completion of probation period.

Prof. Ram Lakhan Meena submitted a request vide letter No. RLM/HoD/Hindi/Lien/2015-16/07 dated 10.06.2015 (*copy enclosed*) to continue in lien as per the decision/implementation of the "mobility of faculty and non-faculty personnel to the newly established Central Educational Institutions (CEIs)" as conveyed vide MHRD letter F.No. 8-9/2008-TS.I dated 13.08.2014.

On the above request, the Executive Council in its 20th meeting dated 29 June 2015 resolved that "matter may be taken up with his parent organization regarding his lien in light of recent instructions issued by the Ministry of HRD for mobility of faculty. The confirmation order may be withheld till the decision in the matter."

The lien in respect of Prof. Meena is extended for another period of one year with effect from 14 August 2015 as communicated by Satyawati College (University of Delhi) vide its letter SC/Admn/549/2015 dated 12 October 2015 (Annexure-F- Page No. 75).

Placed before the Executive Council for consideration

Resolution:

The Executive Council deliberated on the issue and reiterated that Prof. Meena is currently on EOL with extended lien (One year w.e.f. August 14, 2015) from Satyawati College, University of Delhi, Delhi till August 13, 2016. So long as he continues to be on EOL with lien (as per his own request) by holding a substantive position at his parent organisation, his confirmation at Central University Rajasthan cannot be considered. Hence, in view of continuation of his lien, he is considered to be on probation (as confirmation and lien both together are not feasible) till August 13, 2016. He is to be advised (to ensure smooth running of courses) to choose the option of being confirmed at Central University Rajasthan or revert back to his parent organization by the end of this semester i.e. by May 13, 2016.

		A Fact Finding Committee was constituted by the Competent Authority on 6.2.2016 to enquire into the incident of suicide committed by Mr. Mohit Kumar, Ph.D. Research Scholar, Department of Mathematics on 5.2.2016. The committee submitted its report to the Vice Chancellor on 24.2.2016. The recommendations of the committee were placed before the Executive Council.
		Resolution:
		Executive Council accepted the recommendations of the Committee.
		 Immediate Measures: Establishment of Counselling Cell, Ambulance must be well equipped, Emergency health services must be introduced in the campus on 24X7 basis,
		4. Security system in the campus should be thoroughly revamped, strengthened and strictly monitored,5. Commencement of Yoga classes, Meditation and other stress relieving programmes such as dance classes, music classes etc.,
		 6. Sports facility to be strengthened and tutors be appointed, 7. Regular meeting of Students' Grievance Committee and Student Discipline Committee be held at regular intervals. Executive Council approved the recommendation.

Measures for Better Research Environment

- 1. There should be a three member advisory committee for each research scholar just after admission which shall include two faculty members from similar research interest (or closely related topics) from the department and one from sister department.
- 2. After the successful completion of Ph.D. Course work, student should be given an option to choice one of the advisory committee members as his/her research supervisor.
- 3. Students' Advisory Committee should meet atleast once in every three months to discuss the research progress and any other related matter.
- 4. The application for change of Ph.D. Supervisor or any other grievance should be addressed to Head of concerned Department and Copy of the same should be sent to Office of Dean School and Dean Research/Registrar.
- 5. The Head of concerned Department should consult advisory committee of the concerned student and seek their opinion/comments on any grievance or change of supervisor issues within 3 working days from the date of submission of any such application.
- 6. All grievance application should be responded to all concern within 7 working days on the progress and outcome.
- 7. For initially one or two years, the hostel allotment for Ph.D. Scholars should be on sharing basis.
- 8. Monthly meeting with the Students within the deptt./University level should be initiated.
- 9. Each Department should have research scholars club for various academic activities and discussion. The club can have weekly seminar by research scholars and faculty.
- 10. The PhD supervisor is to be decided preferably after Pre-Ph.D. course work. Students should be given enough opportunity to interact with all faculty members of the department before finalizing the topic of interest with the mutual consent of Research Scholar and Supervisor.
- 11. Establishment of Research Cell in the University with dedicated staff for disbursement of scholarship and other matters related to research activities.

Executive Council approved the recommendation.

General Suggestions:

- 1. The problem of disconnect between different officials and committee working in the university need to be reviewed.
- 2. Internet facility in the campus should be reviewed.
- 3. Entry/Exit in the Deptt. / Hostels should be maintained strictly.
- 4. Public relation system should be reviewed regularly.

Executive Council approved the recommendation.

22-4.13 Confidential Item No. 3 – To consider Report of the Committee constituted to look into the complaints by Mr. Yadvendra Singh against Dean (Students Welfare)

A Committee was constituted by the Competent Authority to look into the complaints made by Mr. Yadvendra Singh Shekhawat against Dean (Students Welfare). Mr. Yadvendra also sent an e-mail to the Office of the President of India and Ministry of Human Resource Development for self-immolation in the matter. The committee submitted its report to Hon'ble Vice Chancellor. Recommendations of the Committee are placed before the Executive Council.

"In view of the severe allegation levelled by Prof. R.L. Meena against some of the Committee members, we fear that any decision / comments by the Committee will be misinterpreted. It is, therefore, proper to refer this matter to the competent Committee."

Resolution:

The committee's inability to give a crisp recommendation on the matter due to Dr. Meena's alleged questioning the integrity of the members of the committee is considered as a matter of grave concern. Other matters relating to Dr. Meena also arose during the discussion. It is also reported that Dr. Meena has been making press statements about the University without proper permission of the University authority. He has not been following the protocol of writing to the Chancellor and the Visitor through proper channel. He has been making allegations against several office bearers including the committee members questioning their integrity. The present complaint under consideration is also questioning the style of functioning of Dr. Meena as DSW.

Executive Council felt that detailed investigation by an external committee constituted by the Vice Chancellor should be carried out to bring out the facts of the matter for consideration. The external committee may be of some Senior Professors and Vice Chancellors (Sitting or Former) of other Universities. This committee will examine the complaint of Mr. Yadvendra Singh, the complaints of Dr. Meena and other communications on this matter. It was also suggested that legal opinion is to be obtained for further course of action to be taken as per the recommendation of the above mentioned committee, and in the light of resolution made with reference to agenda item No. 22-4.7 mentioned herein.

22-4.14 To consider nomination of the members on Finance Committee of the University

As per provisions of the Statute 17(1)(iv) of the Central Universities Act, 2009, the Finance Committee shall have three persons nominated by the Executive Council, "out of which at least one shall be a member of the Executive Council".

Under this provision, Dr. D.C. Sharma, Dean, School of Mathematics, Statistics and Computational Sciences was nominated as EC member.

The term of other two members (following members) nominated by EC under this clause (17(1)(iv)) will be completed in May 2016

- 1. Dr N U Siddiquee
- 2. Shri Biju Mathew

The EC may consider nominating two members under 17(1) (iv).

Placed before the Executive Council for consideration.
