TEACHING LEARNING CENTRE (TLC@CURaj)

Teaching Learning Centre (TLC@CURaj) at Central University of Rajasthan was established in the year 2017-18 with a vision of support evidence based teaching and provides diverse opportunities for teachers. It is funded by MHRD, Govt. of India under the Scheme of Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching (PMMMNMTT). It is envisaged to help teachers to modernize their teaching style, to scaffold concepts and information in a way that students can meaningfully take in, and to help students learn more deeply and retain what they have learnt. It is also meant to train teachers about the new and effective methods of teaching. TLC will promote on a continuous basis, discipline-specific curricula, pedagogy, learning materials (including e-content) for use by the teachers in colleges and postgraduate departments.
