55-4.4	Approval for Design of Degree Certificates in horizontal form in bilingual.		
	Previously, the University issued two separate degree certificates (one in English and one in Hindi) for graduating students. This Dual-certificate system has posed challenges in terms of administrative efficiency, document handling, and consistency in formatting. To streamline the process and ensure uniformity, it is proposed to adopt a single bilingual (English-Hindi) degree certificate. The proposed certificate will be designed in a horizontal format having the same enhanced security features, incorporating both languages side by side in a clear and aesthetically balanced layout. This new format will enhance clarity, reduce duplication of work, and improve the student experience by providing a consolidated document. The revised design in horizontal bilingual form is attached as Annexure -D .		
	Resolution: In pursuance of the recommendations of the Academic Council, the Executive Council approved new horizontal Bilingual form Design of Degree Certificates and Certificate of Merit with same Enhanced Security Features.

No. 27-5.1) "To consider the award of work for (i) Construction of Transit Mess and Dining Hall (400 capacity) for B6 Hostel, (ii) Construction of Student Hostel 600 capacity, (iii) Construction of Kendriya Vidyalaya School Building, (iv) Construction of Indoor Sports Complex (Providing Shed for Sports cum Multipurpose Hall), (v) Construction of 250 Bedded Boys Hostel under the scheme of PM-AJAY, (vi) Construction of 250 Bedded Girls Hostel under the scheme of PM-AJAY, (vii) Construction of University Campus Main Gate at CURAJ.		
	The BWC recommended to award the work to L-1 Bidder M/s Jatan Constructions Pvt. Ltd., Ajmer at his quoted rate of Rs. 84,37,14,119.80 (24.30% below quoted rate on ECPT of Rs. 111.45 Crore) and to place it before the Finance Committee and Executive Council.		
	Accordingly, the matter was placed before the 43rd Finance Committee held on 09.06.2025. The FC had also recommended the same.		
	The matter was placed before the Executive Council for perusal and consideration.		
	Resolution: In pursuance of the recommendations of the Building & Works Committee and Finance Committee, the Executive Council approved to award the work to L1 bidder M/s Jatan Constructions Pvt. Ltd., Ajmer with a quoted price of Rs.84,37,14,119.80 (24.30% below from the Estimate).
