

<u>Syllabus for Written test and shortlisting criteria</u> <u>for the post of Deputy Registrar (Lien Vacancy)</u>

Step-I : The written examination will comprise two papers. The criteria for written examination are as follows:

(1) Paper-I: Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs):

Note: The Answer Script of Paper-II of a candidate would be evaluated, only if the candidate qualifies in Paper-I (min. 35 marks).

Remarks : For the convenience of the candidates the detailed syllabus of Paper – II (Descriptive Type) is attached.

Step-II : On the basis of the marks in the written test, shortlisted candidates (in the ratio of 1:15) will be called for interview. University may impose a cut off for the purpose of shortlisting for interview.

Merit of the shortlisted candidates shall be calculated on the basis of the weightage given to experience, certificate and performance in the written test as depicted below:
