Sports & Student Coordinators

League/club and intra-university tournament are managed by students coordinators. The role of the student coordinator is vital in conducting various club/league and intra-university tournaments they are responsible for successful and smooth conduct of such competitions. They perform various duties. There are two sports coordinators – Boy and Girl.

The sports coordinators are directly accountable to the sports department and club presidents. They liaise closely with each other, particularly in the co-ordination of mixed sporting activities. 4. To conduct duties of as umpires, referees and officials for all sporting competitions.

6. To prepare a Sports Bulletin which includes sports results of all teams and fixtures.
7. To liaise with Grounds' Staff regarding preparation of grounds.

- Decisions of Referee /Umpires/Coordinators of each game/event will be final and binding on all participants in any matter. No disputes regarding results shall be entertained.
- Each game is a knock-out series
- Any participant will not be allowed to enter the premises without an ID card (his/her).
- In case of any conflict in the events (TIMINGS), participants should choose one of either.

PLAYER CONDUCT

1. Any player who uses false/ non decorative language or who flagrantly disobeys the rules of the contest, or who flagrantly disagrees...by action or words...with an official decision, shall be expelled from the game. Players will also be ineligible to play in the next game those there team plays.
2. Any player who repeatedly or willfully commits flagrant violations, or who instigates or joins in a fight shall be expelled from that contest and will not be allowed to participate in any further Intra-university or Sports club activities for the remainder of next school year.

TEAM CONDUCT

1. It will be the duty of each team captain to control the actions of all team members representing that team. Any harassment of officials or members of the opposing team, by either player or coach, shall result in the forfeit of that contest. Repeated Violations of this rule will cause the suspension of that team for the remainder of the Intra-University season.
